Others will follow a sequence of courses which will require students to adhere to a prescribed sequence of semesters. Four semesters after completing CI 245/268, students must student teach. ISU requires a 3 credit U.S. diversity course (satisfied by HD FS 240) and a 3 credit international perspective course (usually met through humanities or social science option). HD FS 220 and 221 can be taken concurrently or separately in either order. However, 220 is the prereq for 340 and 221 is the prereq for 343.
